NEW LIFE From Covelli Tennant, this 1930s Odeon chair has been reupholstered in vibrant David Hicks fabric, the original dating from 1968. The colour and pattern is typical of the bold, geometric 'rock star' style of the rule-breaking interior decorator, who turned English interiors on their head in the 1950s and 60s.

Now design duo Sara Covelli and Janie Tennant continue this legacy with their passion for textiles, colour and pattern. Every one of their pieces is unique – sourcing and creating bespoke items such as vintage lighting, framed art deco wallpaper, rare scarves, and upholstered furniture and cushions made from interesting fabrics – as they breathe new life into neglected treasures from the past.
